GRAPES: Barbera 100%.

AREA OF PRODUCTION: the grapes
come from the sunniest vineyards
with red Karst soil in the hills of Moasca,
in the province of Asti.

TERRAIN: clayey-loam.

EXPOSURE: south.

ORGANOLEPTIC CHARACTERISTICS:

Colour: intense red tending towards
garnet, evolving as the wine ages.

Bouquet: very intense, full-bodied with
strong spicy notes, fragrant, mature fruit,
plums, cherries, tending to become
ethereal with aging.

Taste: good structure, fruity and spicy
notes, good balance of acidity and tannins.

ALCOHOLIC STRENGTH: 15-15,5% vol.

RECOMMENDED WITH: game, red meats,
mature cheeses.

SERVING TEMPERATURE:
at room temperature 18°C.

of the city. This Barbera, made
from the grapes of ancient
vines is dedicated to him.
