
# VINTAGE 2021

After a glacial spring that cut off 20% of the harvest, the following summer was gloomy with rain sequences that were hovering the risk of mildew.

The harvest took place in October, recalling the good memories of yesteryear with an ideal weather: little dew in the morning and a cool sun all day...

As if the climate wanted to make up for the rest of the year. As every year, our Petit-Verdot have been vinified entirely in new barrels.

*The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon offer a great range in the mouth. Sublimated by the soft tannins of our Merlot and Petit-Verdot, the aromatic profile of the 2021 vintage is impressive. The palate is velvety, smooth and supported by the beautiful freshness of Cabernet Franc. With natural degrees of 13% vol, this balance will revive the nostalgic minds of the 90s. A less sunny vintage, but more digestible.*
